STANSTED 0-1 BARKING Saturday 2 November 2024 – Essex Senior League – Report by Trevor Gilbert

Barking battled their way to a 1-0 win over Stansted in a fixture which demanded work rate and clinical finishing over quality on the ball in muddy conditions and a difficult pitch.

Stansted did start the better side: debutant Simon Omope bringing down Ashaan Siddik on the left wing of the box after eight minutes and earning himself a yellow card. Siddiq's initial free kick was cleared back out to him and his second attempt was headed on target but collected



comfortably by Purdue. Juwon Akintunde had Barking's first chance two minutes but his low shot was wide of Charlie Turner's near post. Set pieces were important, 23 minutes saw both sides of the pitch introduced to the long throws of Simon Omope, like Siddiq earlier his initial effort was cleared back out to him and his side footed half volley was palmed away from goal by Turner.

The remainder of the first half was devoid of chances and quality from either side, but Stansted again started stronger in the second half with Purdue called into action three minutes into the second half as his strong hands were equal to a strong half-volley. Stansted came the closest of either side after 63 minutes as they rattled the post with a curling effort from the right side of the box and they were made to pay two minutes later, an Omope throw-in went short to Micah Jackson who played it back to Omope with time on the left wing, his cross is squeezed through to **Sam Shaban** on the edge of the six-yard box. Sam's first effort while falling was saved by Turner and his body but it fell back to Shaban and even while on the floor managed to poke the ball past Turner and into the net for a Barking lead.

Stansted left gaps as they pushed forward and the Yellows went close to making them pay. Firstly, with ten minutes to go Sam Edwards hitting the top of the bar from a corner and then with five minutes to go Shaban turned provider for Akintunde but his low effort was blocked by a defender and then smothered by Turner. A foul on Jerrold Cobblah saw Luke Skinner getting a second yellow after 85 minutes. Stansted were entering "last call" territory as their sequence of chances late on started: Portway found himself through on goal and even with a dramatic slip Purdue did well to save with his feet, the ball ended up going for a long throw, more scrambling saw the ball ended up just to the left of the penalty spot and the subsequent shot smacked the crossbar. The rebound ended up going up on the wing of the box with Siddik, he managed to get the ball past Omope but Omope's despairing slide brought Siddik down – earning Stansted a penalty and Omope a second yellow and an early bath. After some internal discussions Charlie Portway stepped up to take the penalty – he attempted to find the bottom right corner with his penalty but he could only find the palm of Purdue who got down quickly and not only saved the penalty but removed any further danger as he palmed the ball wide of goal.

Missing those chances took all the wind from Stansted's sails and Barking saw out injury to record a vital three points and a clean sheet that was a long time coming.



FRENFORD

Frenford clubs was founded in 1928 by Jack Carter, originally as a boys club. By 1930 it had grown into a sports and social club and during the war years Frenford Senior Football Section was started, playing in the local football league in various venues in Ilford and the surrounding area. Up until the 1970s Frenford had only one men's side. In the early 70s Frenford reserve side was started mostly made up of the under 18s boys' team. We now run a number of teams who play in The Essex Senior Reserve Football League, The Essex Alliance League and The Essex Vets League. On the field the club has enjoyed many successful seasons in the leagues in which they have played and are now one of the most well-known clubs in this area. No club of any sporting interest can withstand the test of time without the support of its members and their families. Perhaps one of the clubs' greatest strengths is its ability and willingness to call upon its members for an environment of friendship and team spirit. Therefore, it can certainly be said that this club's greatest asset are its members and their families.

Over the past 10 years Frenford has developed its Youth and Women's section, adding to our 5 Saturday Teams. Frenford now has a record 30 teams across all sections and has an enormous presence in the Community delivering projects at various venues, schools and most notably working with the Police to support and deter young people from crime.

Our First teams reached new heights and made History, by winning the Thurlow Nunn South Division League in the 2022/23 season and were promoted into the Essex Senior League.

BARKING 2-1 FRENFORD

Saturday 30 March 2024 – Essex Senior League – Report by Trevor Gilbert

Barking rode their luck but in the end took away another three points to keep their impressive run of form going with a 2-1 victory over Frenford. First half goals from Sam Dowridge and the returning Wale Odedoyin were enough despite a late fightback from Frenford.

The previously mentioned Wale Odedoyin made his first appearance and scored his first Barking goal since November 2015 and we welcomed Joe



Chidyausiku who was a second half substitute. Frenford had some ex-Barking players themselves in Tom Troubridge, Kai Haysman, Osa Otote and Georgie Fairhead.

The Blues looked comfortable early on with the ball and were rewarded with a gift after five minutes as Tom Troubridge clearly handled from a Jack Folan corner – **Sam Dowridge** stepped up to take the penalty and despite the best efforts of Frenford goalkeeper Jimmy Parker the ball nestled in the bottom left corner of the net to give Barking an early lead.

Wale Odedoyin went close minutes later as he attempted to convert from Brad Rowland's low cross but his effort bounced wide. Dan Purdue was forced into his only action of the first half after 24 minutes as he did well to punch away a long-range shot. The Blues doubled their lead after 29 minutes: the Frenford defenders and keeper Parker failed to deal with a long ball and it fell gratefully at the feet of **Wale Odedoyin** who passed the ball into the open net.

The last 15 minutes of the first half passed without much incident and Barking had a chance for their third just after the restart: a counterattack saw Odedoyin drive forward and the ball fell to Luke Hirst but his deflected half volley went just wide of the post. There was one chance for Frenford just before the hour mark but the shot was dragged comfortably wide of the goal. Their task was made harder after 73 minutes – a case of handbags before a throw-in was taken saw a red card for Mohammed Diaby for slapping Karl Kayembe, while cautions were handed out to Barking's Chidyausiku and Purdue. The reduction to ten men for Frenford handed Barking some openings and they should have had the game out of sight minutes after the dismissal, a cross from Brad Rowland was palmed out to Warren Kayembe who saw his effort cleared off the line before he headed the rebound against the crossbar. Barking was made to sweat in injury time as far too much time was given to Georgie Fairhead and his inch-perfect cross was nodded home by Nick Reynolds. However, the home side managed to squeeze their way through some nervy added minutes for another three points that consolidated their playoff position.
