- 5: Being drunk or under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 6: Making vulgar or obscene gestures.
- 7: Carrying any offensive object or throwing any article onto the field of play.
- 8: No glass bottles, drinking glasses or other such article or object to be permitted.
- 9: Sitting on the perimeter fence is not permitted. All vehicles are parked at the owner's/ driver's risk.
- 10: Spectators are not permitted to bring or play with Footballs in the stadium

# HULLBRIDGE SPORTS 0-4 BARKING FC

*Saturday 17 February 2024- Essex Senior League – Report by Trevor Gilbert*

Barking made it 16 unbeaten with a convincing and complete 4-0 victory over fellow top half side Hullbridge Sports. The Yellows went into halftime leading by a single goal thanks to Tony Martin who doubled the lead from the spot just after half time before goals for Brad Rowland and Luke Hirst completed the job.

Hullbridge managed by former Blues boss Justin Gardner fielded no less than seven ex-Barking players in their match day squad. We welcomed Colin Mugoya-Tabingwa who was a second half substitute.

The visitors went close after just two minutes as Bleron Ademi's chipped cross was met by Sam Dowridge but his header back across goal was just wide. Barking went even closer after 11 minutes as Dowridge turned provider from a free kick as his cross found George Forrest but his effort hit the base of the post. Hullbridge suggested they could cause problems while in possession but Barking took a deserved lead after 25 minutes: Max Spence's long ball fell to Luke Hirst who slid **Tony Martin** through on goal and his powerful effort was simply too good for Lamar Joseph-Johnson in the home goal and the ball rocketed into the bottom corner of the net for our 50th league goal of the season.

Hullbridge thought they had an equaliser five minutes later as former Barking striker Michael Dixon found the net but he was flagged for offside.

That was it for the first half, and whatever was said in the Hullbridge dressing room at half time was surely set on fire a minute in as Luke Hirst latched onto Shaye La-Rose's ball over the top, advanced into the box and he was tripped by Michael Agboola, leaving the referee with an easy decision to award a penalty. **Tony Martin** stepped up and sent Joseph-Johnson the wrong way as the ball nestled into the bottom right corner of the net.

Hullbridge's task was made even harder after 60 minutes as Sam Owusu was shown a second yellow card for a rash tackle on Martin. The Yellows made them pay after 73 minutes – constant pressure led to Barking winning the ball back and it fell to substitute **Brad Rowland** and his piledriver from the corner of the box took a small nick off a defender on its way through and that was enough to take it past the arm of Joseph-Johnson and into the net.

Barking continued to play good football and keep the pressure on Hullbridge and Hirst got his reward for another good performance – Warren Kayembe slid towards a through ball which rebounded off both himself and Joseph-Johnson before kindly falling to **Luke Hirst** who tapped into an empty net to round off another great day for Barking.

This latest result takes us up to sixth behind Athletic Newham who we have two games in hand over and play at the Lawtech Stadium in a few weeks' time. Of more immediate concern as we play Ilford at home in seven days, a positive result will equal the club record run for league and cup of 17 games set in season 1968/69.

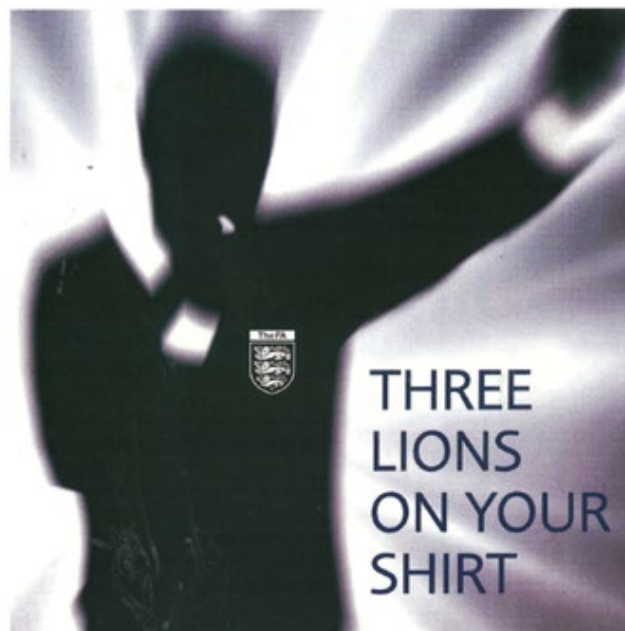

# ILFORD FC

Not only were Ilford one of the most famous names in amateur football for almost a century, but from 1904 to 1977 they played at one of its most celebrated venues. As well as being on hand to witness Ilford's many successes, the 18,000 capacity Lynn Road ground at Newbury Park staged Olympic Games matches, Amateur Internationals, an FA Amateur Cup Final, plus countless other cup finals and representatives matches.



Formed in 1881, Ilford were founder members of both the Isthmian and Southern Leagues, the latter from which they resigned to be replaced by an emergent Tottenham Hotspur.

Ilford secured four-acres of initially undeveloped land at Lynn Road in 1904 and huge crowds by today's standards necessitated developments which transformed the site into one of the best stadiums in the country.

Over the next five decades Ilford FC was comfortably one of the amateur game's most successful clubs. Captain, Joe Dines, along with Ilford teammates William Martin and Leonard Dawe returned from the Stockholm Olympics with gold medals. Dines was duly signed by Liverpool... After winning consecutive championships in 1920/21 and 1921/22, the club embarked on its famed European tours, competing against FC Barcelona on four occasions (drawing twice) and beating Ajax 3-1, in Amsterdam. Back-to-back Amateur Cup triumphs confirmed this reputation. Four and even five-figure crowds were witnessed at Lynn Road during the period.

By 1951 nearly all the banking around the ground had been concreted, giving Newbury Park an 18,000 capacity with 1,400 seats, while in 1957 the covered accommodation was extended further still when a roof was erected over the terracing at the Ley Street end. But for the installation of floodlights in 1962, the ground remained unchanged for the remainder of its existence, even retaining its splendid white wicket fencing that spanned the four sides of the ground.

Further Wembley finals in 1958 and 1972 could not disguise the declining allure of the old amateur game. With increasing overheads, the old ground was put up for sale in 1977. Fans were seduced by the promise of a new, purpose-built stadium one mile away at Fairlop. This failed to materialise, following a tax bill which to this day is shrouded in mystery. A succession of ill-conceived mergers from which only today's Dagenham and Redbridge FC emerged the winner, tragically sealed Ilford's fate.... (but not quite)!

Supporters and officials of the old club managed to reform Ilford FC against all the odds, in 1987. After a protracted 8-year campaign with Redbridge Council, agreement was reached over the use of Cricklefield Stadium in the High Road (curiously a venue coveted by the club when doubts about their tenure at Lynn Road first emerged in the 1960s).

Successive developments have seen the pitch extended, the ground fully enclosed and £1m was raised to support the building of the clubhouse in 2002. As well as being a fine stadium, Cricklefield also provides a link to the old ground in the form of the Sir Herbert Dunnico Memorial Gates -presently awaiting restoration as part of a recent Heritage Lottery Grant, awarded to enable the club to extend its work in the local community.

## LAST TIME: ILFORD 1-5 BARKING FC

*Saturday 21 October 2023 – Essex Senior League – Report by Trevor Gilbert*

Barking came back from a poor start to comfortably despatch Ilford by 5 goals to 1. The scores were level going into halftime thanks to Tom Troubridge's equaliser before a brace from Luke Hirst and goals from debutant Jake Gordon and Gael Kileba for the second successive Saturday rounded off the day.

In winning this game it meant for the first time this season we recorded two league victories on the bounce and Luke Hirst after scoring a hat trick last season in a 5-2 victory to make it five in two games against the Foxes. It didn't seem like it was going to go Barking's way after just one minute: Harry Rawlins latched onto a long ball and turned Fahad Nyanja, deputising at right back, before despatching the ball across the returning Harry Girling and into the bottom corner of the net. Ilford kept it right at the back and Barking struggled to make moments of quality but got a much-needed equaliser on the half hour, a free kick from deep landed at the feet of **Tom Troubridge** who rifled a half volley from the edge of the box past the diving right hand of Tim Pitman and into the net.

After the break Barking looked very comfortable on the ball and hit Ilford with a three goal, six-minute combo to knock the stuffing out of them. **Luke Hirst** put Barking in the lead after 54 minutes, latching onto Jake Gordon's through ball before exquisitely dinking the ball over Pitman and into the net.

**Jake Gordon** turned scorer from provider moments later, as he received Jack Dickinson's cutback, squeezed the ball past the defender and prodded the ball low past Pitman to make it 3-1. **Luke Hirst** added his second and Barking's fourth on the hour mark as Gael Kileba was found by a crossfield ball before squaring to Luke Hirst who had an easy tap-in from close range.

Ilford were left shell shocked at Barking's rampant phase and failed to land any punches on a comfortable Blues side who brought Addae Papponette onto the pitch, as well as debutants Oumar Ndao and Kelvin Boampong. Papponette managed to find Kileba through on goal but his side footed effort was over the bar. The Barking wide man did get his reward for a good performance on the 90-minute mark, Jake Gordon switched the play with **Gael Kileba** nodding the ball forward after it just evaded the defender then rebounding the ball off Pitman and half-volleying the ball into an empty net for Barking's fifth with the full-time whistle following a few minutes later.

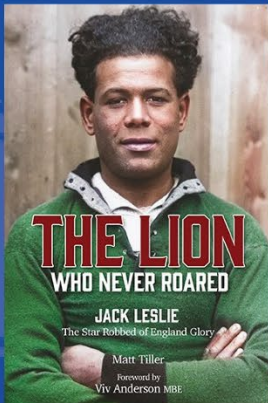

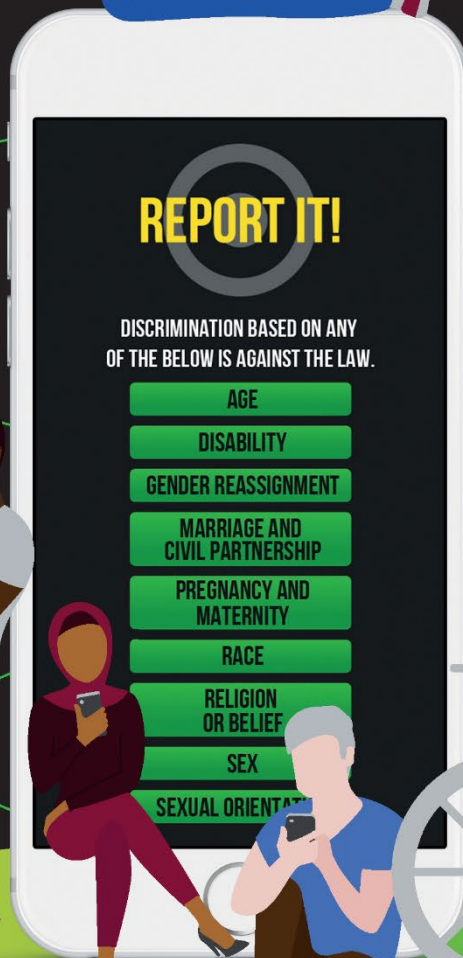
