# SAFFRON WALDEN TOWN 2-1 BARKING

*Saturday 8 February 2025 – Essex Senior League – Report by Trevor Gilbert*

Barking were defeated by the odd goal in three in a throwback game at Saffron Walden Town on a pitch that did well to hold up after some extensive rain. An early own goal gave the home side the lead, before Sam Shaban equalised from the penalty spot but Kaleel Green scored with ten to go to give the home side all three points.



It couldn't have started any worse for the Yellows, a low cross into the box bobbling around for Teddy Stacey to swing a leg at it but instead of going forward it looped towards goal and debutant goalkeeper Akan George could palm the ball into the net while wrongfooted and stretching with the home side's Solomon Ofori getting a touch along the way. Saffron Walden nearly doubled their lead after five minutes as they broke the Barking line but George did well to stay low and save with his feet. Barking's first chance came at the ten-minute mark and it was a good one, the Yellows beating the defensive line over the top, with Tony Martin latching onto the ball and advancing on goal but his effort ended up in the side netting. After the initial chances the game could not get going, the pitch starting to cut up after the rain fall meant neither side was able to get into any rhythm. It took until first half injury time for another chance of note and the home side nearly doubled their lead: Ofori caused Barking nightmares all day and he went in on goal from a flick on but although his effort beat George it crept just wide of the post.

Barking started the second half infinitely better and fired their first warning after 53 minutes, with substitute Juwon Akintunde through on goal and looking to get a shot away before an excellent recovery tackle from Ricky Modeste. The home side continued to look dangerous on the counter with their fast front line but Barking continued to be looking the most likely to score next with Walden keeper James Askew forced into his first save as he got down quickly to turn his own defenders deflection on a cross away from goal. Barking had their moment after 66 minutes, Akintunde again through on goal, but this time he was clipped by Askew as he attempted to round him resulting in a penalty. Askew was cautioned and Modeste was sin binned for his protestations. Eventually, **Sam Shaban** stepped up and sent Askew the wrong way for a deserved Barking equaliser on the balance of play and a goal which was our 50th league goal this season.

Barking couldn't capitalise on the player advantage for ten minutes, the only chance coming right at the end as Akintunde's turn and shot was saved by the feet of Askew. As the advantage ended for Barking their own deficit started, this time Caleb Dennis finding himself in the sin bin with under fifteen minutes remaining. The home side did take advantage and scored the winner after 80 minutes, Kaleel Green turning the Yellows defence inside out before advancing on goal, his first effort was well saved by George but unfortunately for Barking the rebound fell close to Green who slid the ball into the net. Walden expertly controlled the remaining time, even when Barking got back their full quota on the pitch. They will feel they deserved the three points, while Barking need to turn their attention to another tough fixture midweek against Takeley this coming Tuesday.

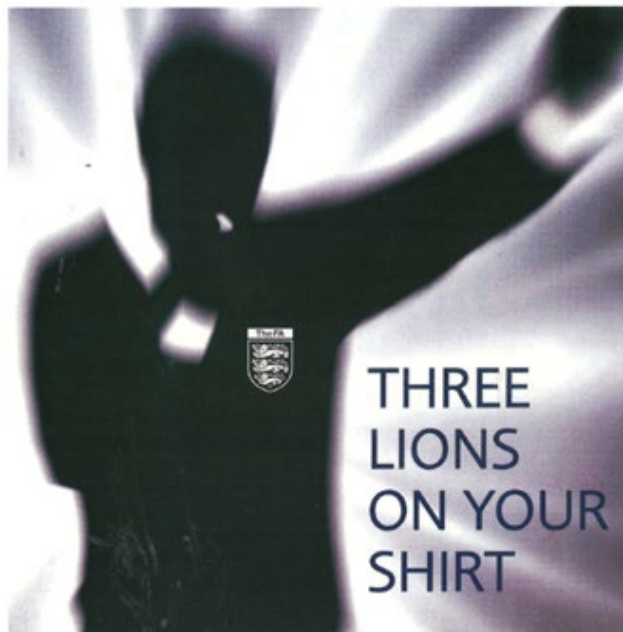

# TAKELEY

One theory is that the name derives from the 'Teg-Ley' of 'sheep-clearing', i.e. a part of the forest cleared for sheep rearing. Another is that it is from the name 'Taecca', a Saxon lord who owned much land in these parts and in Oxfordshire where, strangely enough, there is a village called Tackley. Current thinking is that the name Takeley should be interpreted as "settlement next to open forest". Nearby is the Roman Stane Street, joining the ancient Roman forts of Colchester and St Albans.

Takeley Football Club is believed to have been formed in 1903, but little is known about those early times. The Club became affiliated within the Bishop's Stortford, Stansted and District Football League (BSS&DFL) at the end of the First World War. The original pitches were in Hatfield Forest, moving to Station Road opposite to their present home ground. Additional pitches for the Club at the Recreation Ground just past Takeley Park have been arranged by the good offices of Takeley Parish Council. The club is well looked after by local businessmen: - Andrew Silvester, our President, Pat Curran, Chairman and Mick Rabey, Secretary together with local volunteers and active committee members. The manager of the First Team is Marc Das, supported by coach & assistant manager Andy Walker. Takeley's status in Non-League Football has risen beyond dreams over a short period. From early beginnings with the BSS&DFL Second Division, the Club has risen through the Essex Olympian League and now to the Essex Senior League, winning numerous trophies along the way. With a Reserve team in the Essex Senior Reserve League and two U18 teams in the Southern Floodlit and Royston & Crowe Leagues, Takeley goes from strength to strength.

Following a fire of the old wooden shack that served as changing facilities, volunteers and supporters rebuilt a first-class pavilion, with excellent facilities in 2001.

**2007/8** 1<sup>st</sup> team promoted to Essex Senior League. Reserves promoted to Essex Olympian league. The Club volunteers constructed a 125-seat stand, which followed the installation of a state-of-the-art floodlighting system.

**2008/9** 1<sup>st</sup> team won the Anagram Records Trophy 3-1 on penalties after extra time was level at 2-2. On 29 April 2008, Takeley hosted West Ham Utd in a match, with Lucas Neil former player with the Hammers and an Australian International Captain switching on the floodlights in front of a crowd of 500. Although West Ham won 4-1, with players including Jack Collison, Junior Stanislas and James Tomkins

**2010/11** Takeley has a high capacity-seating stand and a newly completed wall and nets off the main road. A new canteen, independent toilet facility and Committee Room, with enhanced players and officials' facilities, renamed after the late Secretary Lee Borham. Brand new turnstiles fitted to the Clubs grounds. On 14<sup>th</sup> August Takeley 1st team play the first ever FA Cup game against Hertford Town and were featured on the front of the FA website, along with numerous other sports pages, including the BBC.

**2011/12** History made for Takeley FC as the first ever women's football match took place at Station Road. Club website upgraded and modernized.

**2016/17 U18's.** Achieving success in their league cup final 2-1 against Hitchin Town Hawks, they then went on to beat BS Swifts on 30<sup>th</sup> April, 6-1 to clinch the league, achieving the double and finishing top of Division 1 Royston Crow Youth League five points clear.

**2016/17 First Team** achieved fourth in the league – Their aim at the start of the season was a top four finish! By this time, they had already won the Gordon Brasted Memorial Trophy and then went on to win the league cup.

# BARKING 4-3 HALSTEAD TOWN

*Saturday 1 February 2025 – Essex Senior League – Report by Trevor Gilbert*

Barking came away with all three points in a tense seven goal thriller against a Halstead Town side that refused to give in, the two fixtures against today's opponents this season have yielded a total of fourteen goals.

The teams went in level at half time, with Barking's goals coming from Sam Edwards and Tony Martin. Barking pulled away in the second half, thanks to a free kick that might have come off Tony Martin and a first Barking goal for Tyrese Sibanda, before being pegged back late on by Halstead for a nervy finish.



Both sides had chances in the first ten minutes as Sibanda saw his shot saved by the feet of Halstead stopper Jack Cherry while Halstead went close themselves with a curling half volley attempt from Joel Older that was wide of the mark. It was Barking who did take the lead at the ten-minute mark, Caleb Dennis seemed to be closing in on goal before an excellent tackle led to a corner, Sam Edwards took it short to Sam Shaban, he backheeled to **Sam Edwards** who slotted it low and under Cherry into the net.

Halstead were back level quickly however, as Barking failed to deal with pressure, after some brave blocks the ball fell to Lester Ward who rifled a shot into the net with Dan Purdue left without a chance to save it. Halstead completed the comeback after 26 minutes; a long ball fell between the defence and Purdue and with both unsure on how to deal with it George Frodsham had time to get in-between them and slot the ball low into the net. Fahad Nyanja squeezed past some defenders to find the side netting from a narrow angle on 36 minutes but Barking got an important equaliser in first half injury time, Tyrese Sibanda drove down the right wing before crossing perfectly for **Tony Martin**, he saw his close-range shheader saved by Cherry but the ball fell kindly to the Barking striker and he gratefully bundled home the rebound.

Barking completed the one-two punch on 53 minutes, a foul on Dennis led to Sam Edwards stepping up for a free kick from the left wing of the box. His curling cross invited everyone as it drifted across goal and was possibly nodded on by **Tony Martin** as Cherry was left stranded with the ball nestling in the bottom right corner of the net. Halstead nearly had an immediate reply as they again drove through the middle of Barking's defence but as the attacker found himself through on goal he dragged the ball wide of goal. Barking punished that miss and doubled their lead after 64 minutes when Akilijo Balliu found **Tyrese Sibanda** in space on the edge of the box and he had time to open his body up and perfectly side foot his shot into the bottom right corner of the net.

Halstead kept pushing however, and they had a route back into the game with five minutes remaining. Firstly, an excellent save from Purdue after a cross to the far post led to a corner which Barking failed to deal with properly and the ball came back across goal and a dangerous low cross found Alfie Cleal who had the easy job of tapping the ball home from close range. Barking should have made the game safe after 87 minutes as they countered the continuing Halstead pressure but Caleb Dennis skied his effort well clear of the bar. In recent weeks it has been Barking benefitting from late goals, but they were nearly punished in the final moments, a corner to the far post inexplicably finding a free Halstead striker, his header back across goal seems destined to equalise with Purdue stranded but Dennis amongst the crowd of players had made his way back onto the line and his vital header just cleared the ball before it crossed the goal line, despite the celebrations of the Halstead players. The final whistle blew shortly after and a relieved Barking took all of the points.

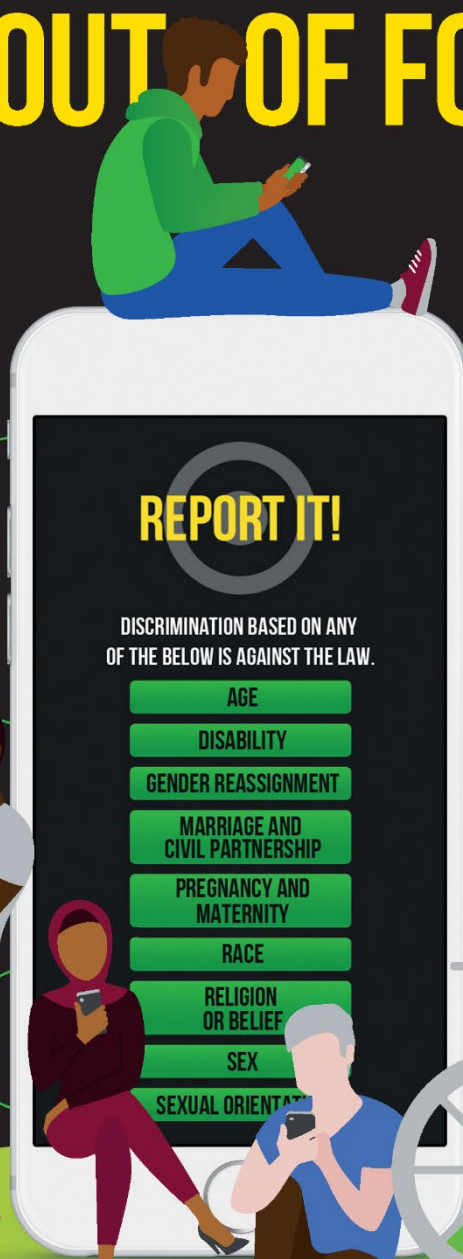
